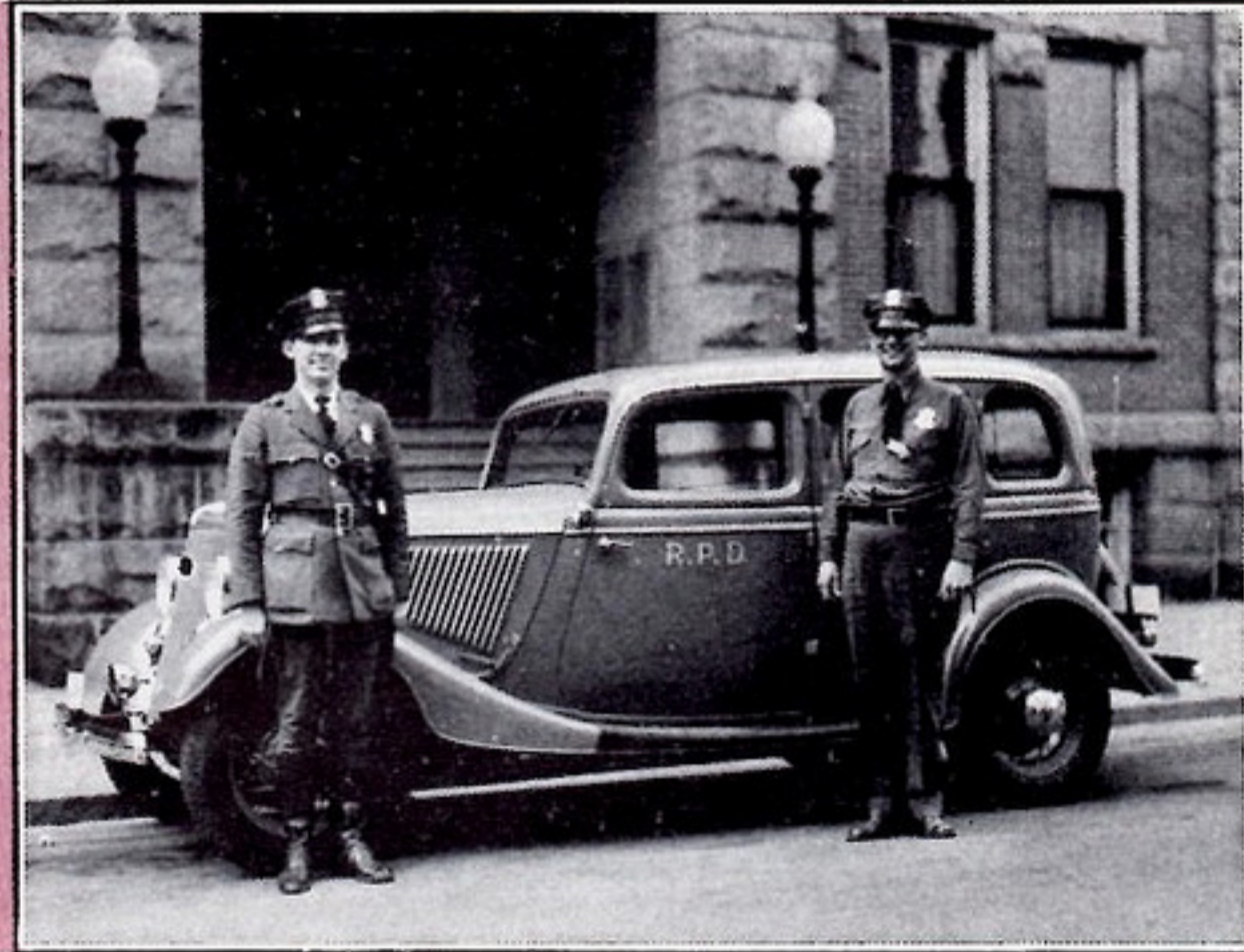

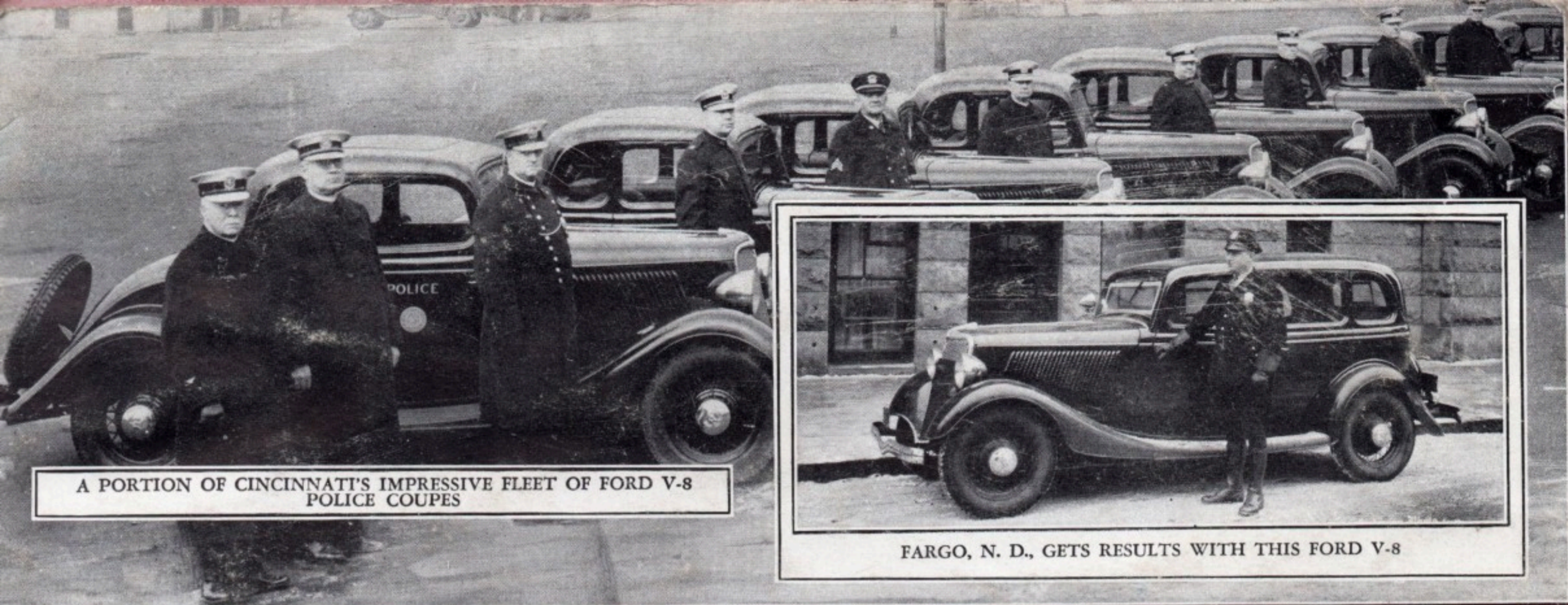

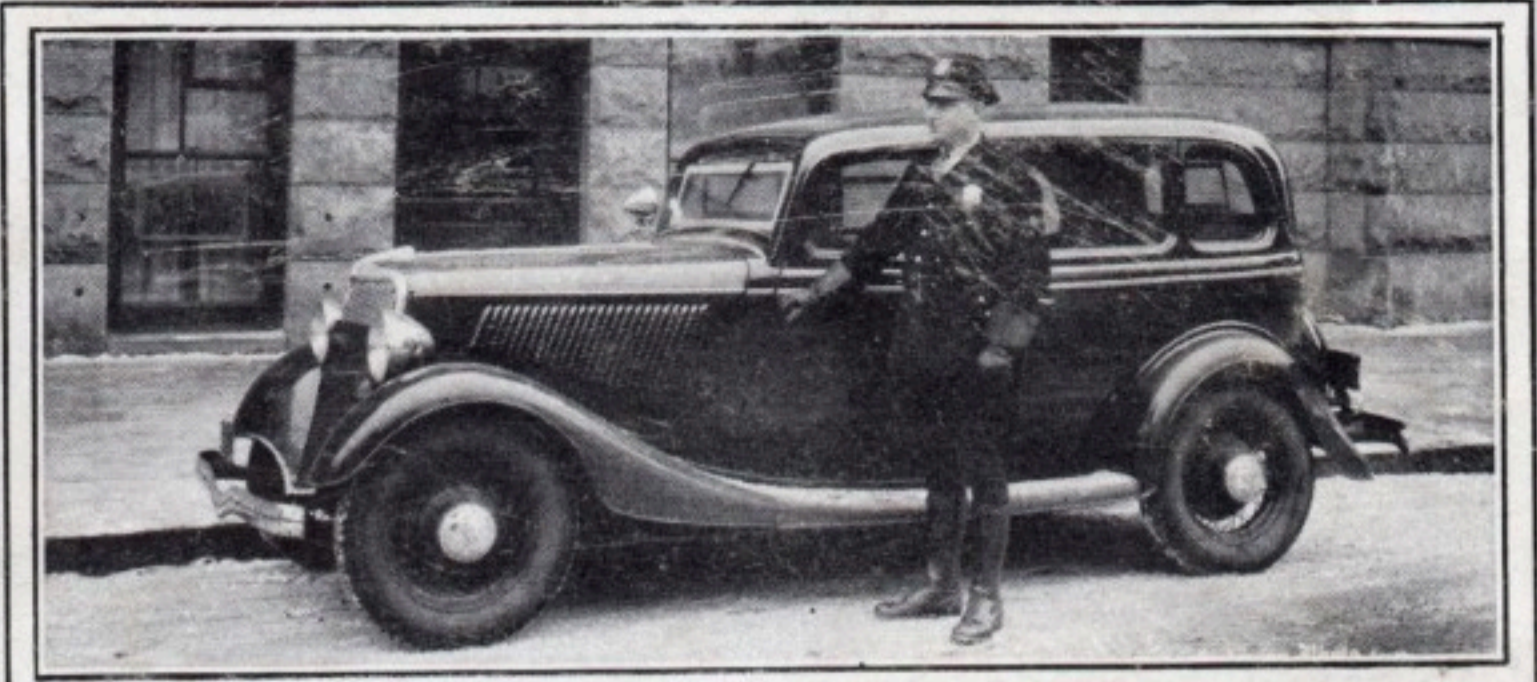


19 FORD V-8's ASSIGNED TO THE STATE POLICE OF NEW YORK

A PORTION OF CINCINNATI'S IMPRESSIVE FLEET OF FORD V-8 POLICE COUPES



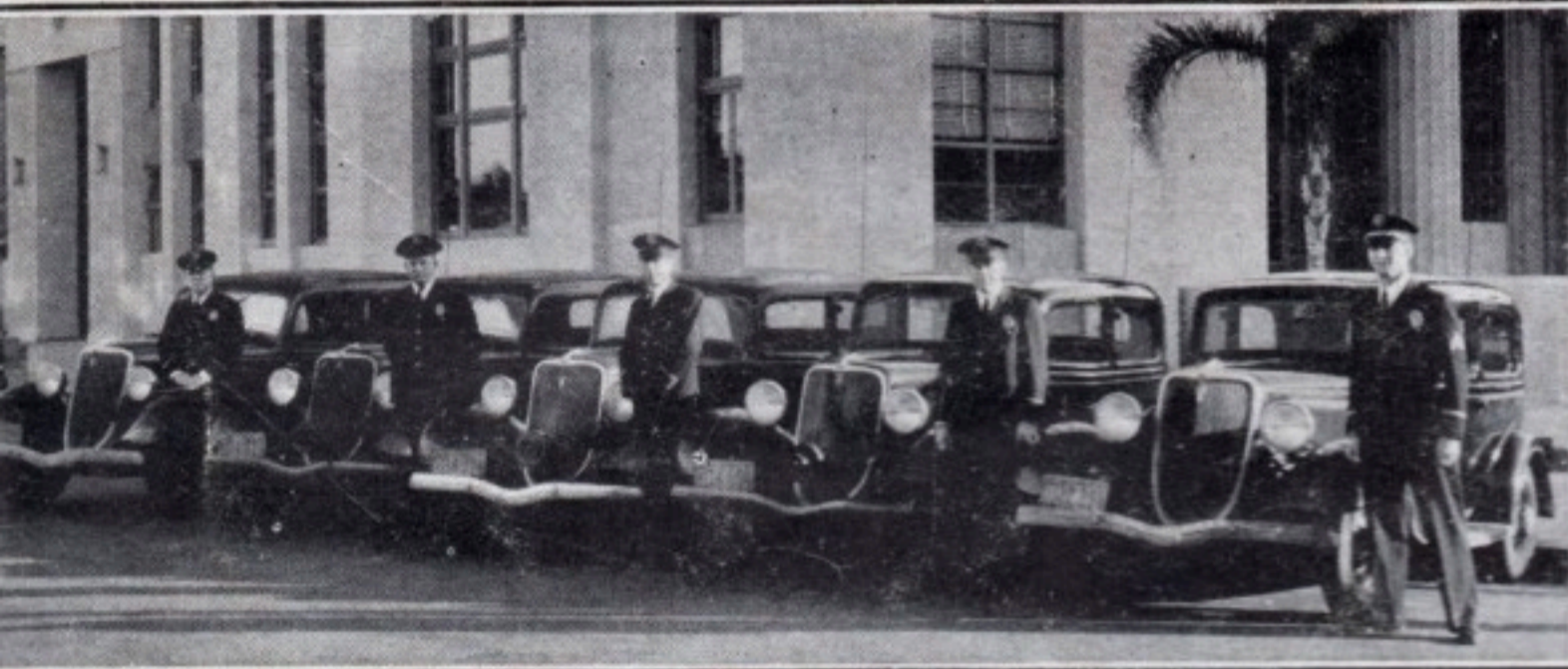

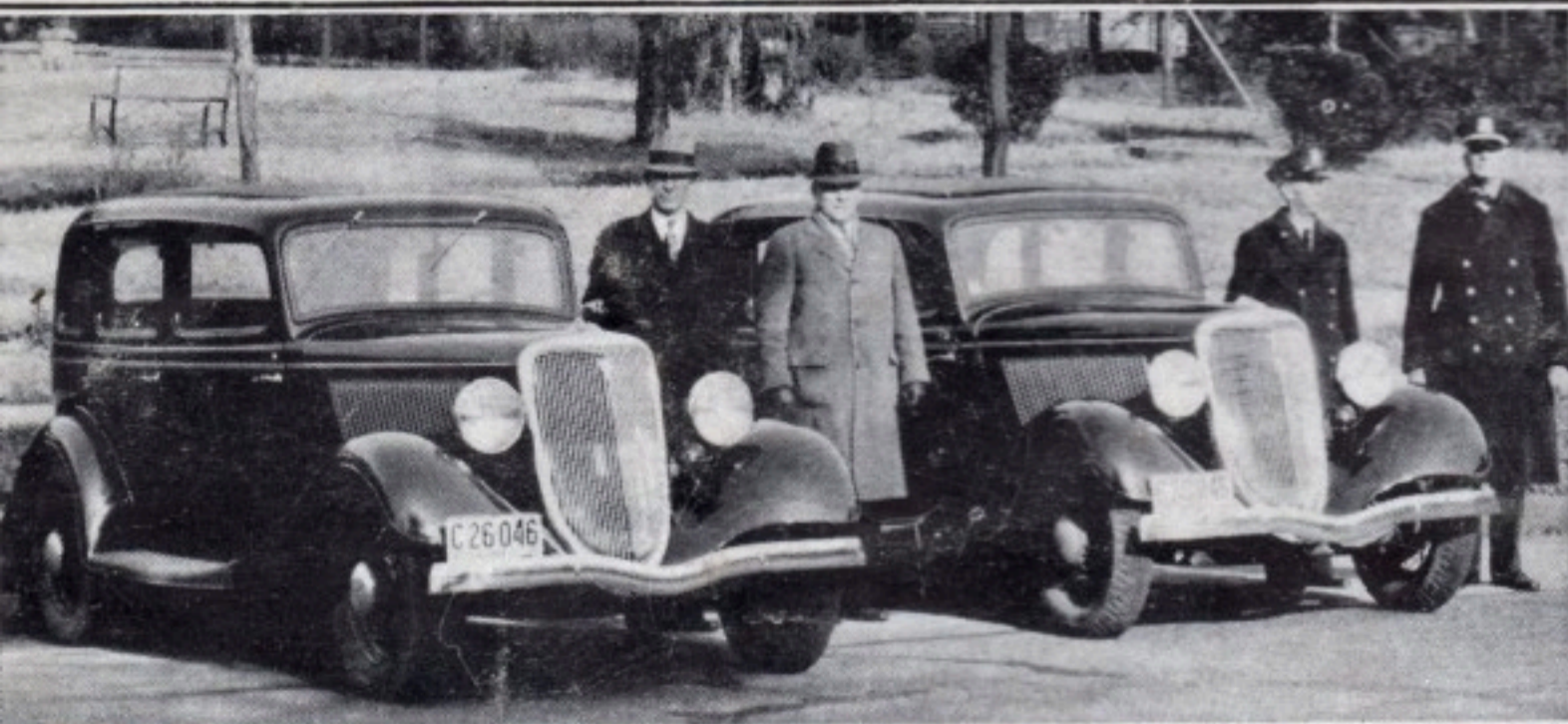
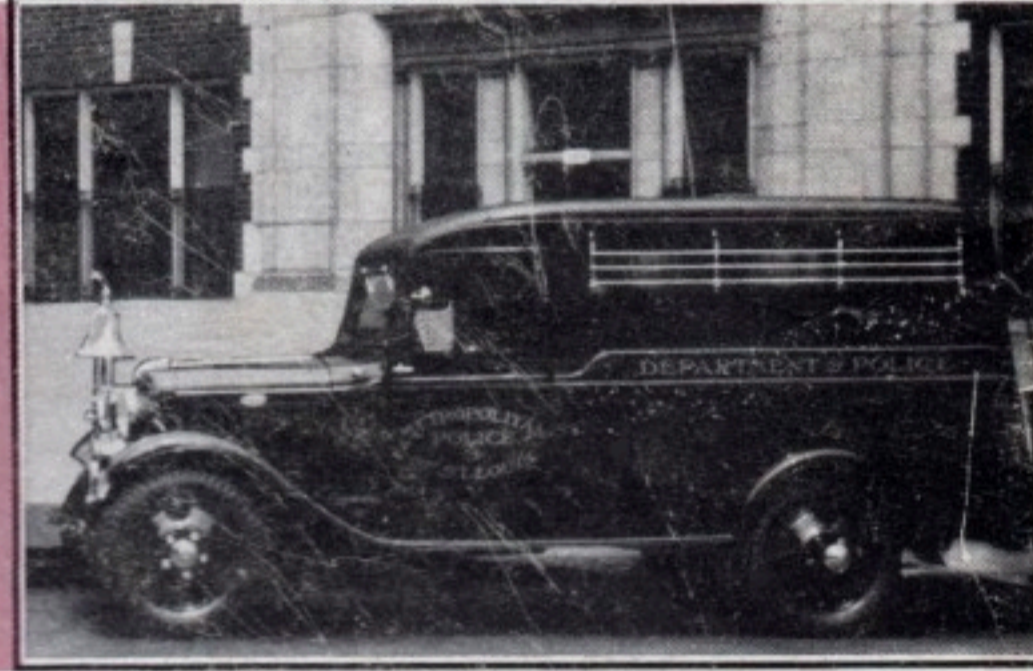

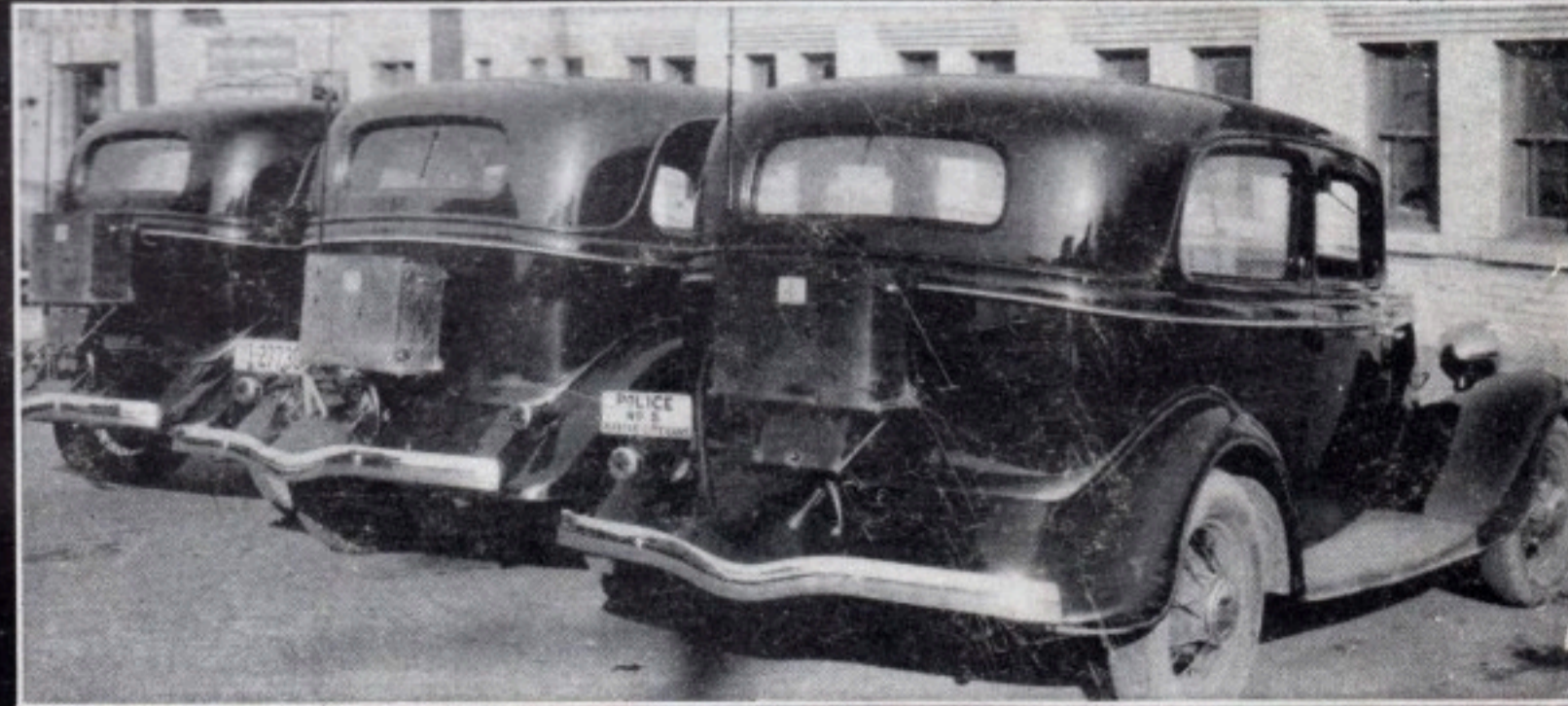
