SAFETY GLASS ALL AROUND AT NO EXTRA COST—The mort important 1938 feature of the Station Wagon is Safety Glass as standard equipmort in all doors, side and rear windows. Does and side windows are adjustable. The rear windows for and side windows are adjustable. The rear window can also be opened and held in position by brackets. SPARE WHIEL AND THE MOUNTED BRIDIND FROM SEAT—The space wheel and tire are now mounted behind the driver's seat. A cloth tire rover protects clother of passengers. With the space inside, the tail gate is lighter, easier to close. The window above tail gate is hinged at the top. It can be clamped at maximum opening where it will not interfere with boading. Room for casy access to the rear is provided at the right of the center seat. Each seat holds three. Rear seat can replace center seat.
