Lincoln seats are scientifically contoured. They are triple-cushioned with China cotton, soft, foam-rubber and rubberized hair for supreme riding ease.











The truss-type structure is achieved by welding strong internal members to the sturdy steel floor. Note the diagonal steel reinforcements which run forward from the base of the windshield.

You and your passengers ride in steel-clad protection with a stanch foundation that provides unusual stability and handling ease. Scientific application of insulating materials results in operating quietness.





All the beauty and artistry of the original design have been perfectly executed in the new segmented grille. When installed, auxiliary road lamps set flush with the grille.







A masterpiece in power plant engineering, the Lincoln engine possesses enduring qualities of all-round performance that place it in a field uniquely its own. With a high power-to-weight ratio, this great engine is deliberately designed for a high degree of flexibility seldom equaled. It delivers swift, silent power at relatively slow engine speeds for brilliant performance to meet all operating conditions you may encounter.

Of course, Lincoln world-famous standards of fine precision contribute in large measure to the unusual performance of Lincoln engines and are responsible for their virtual freedom from constant

service attention. The hydraulic valve lifters, for example, eliminate any need for valve adjustment since they maintain constant zero clearance for continuous, silent operation at all times.

And better still, this superb Lincoln power plant is ready for normal driving speeds the day you get your new car—thanks to the craftsmanship, precision and careful testing exercised in its manufacture.

Engine—V-12, L-head type with cylinders and crankcase cast en-bloc. Bore and stroke 2.937" x 3.75"; total displacement 305 cubic inches; taxable horsepower rating 41.4; developed brake horsepower 130 @ 3800 r.p.m. Engine suspension 3 point rubber mountings. Four main bearing crankshaft fully counterweighted and mounted in removable steel-backed bearings. Compression ratio 7.1 to 1. Cast alloy-steel pistons fitted with two compression and one oil control rings. Silent gear camshaft drive. Alloy-steel exhaust valve seat inserts. Hydraulic, self-adjusting silent type valve lifters. Pressure type oiling system with full pressure to main, connecting rod and camshaft bearings, valve lifters, with overflow to camshaft drive gears. New larger positive gear-type oil pump. Oil filter of quickly replaceable cartridge type.

Cooling System—Dual leakproof water pumps located at forward ends of each cylinder bank. High efficiency fan mounted

on crankshaft with built-in vibration damper. Full length cylinder water jacketing. Cooling capacity 26.5 quarts.

Fuel System—Dual down-draft carburetor equipped with intake silencer and oil bath air cleaner which is 98% efficient. Thermostatically controlled manifold heat control. Mechanically driven fuel pump with filter. Fuel tank capacity 19.5 U. S. gallons.

Clutch—Single-plate, semi-centrifugal type with low pedal pressure. Throw-out levers equipped with needle bearings for positive, easy action. Pre-lubricated, ball-type clutch release bearing.

Transmission—Three-speed type equipped with helical silent type gears in all speeds. Main shaft and countershaft mounted on anti-friction bearings. Second and third speed gears fitted with blocker type synchronizers for smooth, quiet shifting. Steering post gearshift with rubber insulated linkage for ultra-

quiet operation. (Automatic overdrive is available at extra cost.)

Final Drive—Torque-tube type with springs relieved of all driving and braking forces for smooth easy riding comfort. Three-quarter floating rear axle with hypoid drive gears. Ratio 4.22 to 1.

Brakes—Super-hydraulic with cast-iron drums. Self-energizing action decreases pedal pressure required for positive, quick, straightline stops.

Ride—Long, slow-action springs with rubber insets between the leaves dissipate the smallest road shocks. Adjustable, double-acting hydraulic shock absorbers combined with balanced weight distribution, mid-section seating and luxury type seats set an unsurpassed standard in riding comfort.

Two-Way Stabilization—Two-way stabilization results in excellent roadability and handling ease. Transverse stabilizer on front maintains alignment between axle and body frame to minimize side-sway. Torsional ride stabilizer reduces "roll," keeps the car on an even keel when driving on rough roads, improving stability and riding comfort.

Unit Body-Frame—Unit type body-frame on all closed body types. Internal bridge truss construction with steel floor welded integrally with body into a rigid twistproof unit. Bridge-floor type frame on all convertible models with double box-section frame members for utmost rigidity.

Wheels and Tires—Pressed steel wheels with drop-center rims of 5-inch width for long tire life. Tires 7.00 x 15, 4-ply.

Shipping Measurements—Wheelbase—125 inches; width—77.82 inches; Lincoln, over-all length—218.68 inches, maximum height—68.5 inches. Lincoln Continental, over-all length—219.61 inches, maximum height—63.1 inches.

Smart Style—For 1946, Lincoln features smart styling which is distinctive and new. The die-cast segmented radiator grille finished in sparkling chrome adds to the low, wide appearance characteristic of Lincoln's streamlined design. The front bumper is wide to safeguard front fenders, and new bumper guards provide greater protection to the radiator grille and headlamps. The long, tapered hood is fitted with modern winged-type ornament which accents fleet appearance. Ornamental name plates in the same style theme as the radiator grille decorate the hood sides.

Beautiful Interiors—The spacious Lincoln interiors are handsomely finished in expertly tailored fabrics and leathers. heather blue broadcloth, rope and stripe weave cord cloth in light tan or blue. The Convertible Coupe is smartly finished appearance. Rear center arm rest is included.

Plastic fittings in deep garnet harmonize with the smartly styled instrument panel. Unusually complete appointments complement the softly blending colors of the fine upholstery materials. The chair-high seats are extra wide, extra deep and are cushioned with a padding of foam rubber for utmost comfort. Both the Club Coupe and Convertible Coupe provide ample room for six passengers; front seats tilt inward and forward for easy entrance.

Choice of Upholstery—In closed body models, there is a choice of three luxurious fabrics from which to choose: rich heather blue broadcloth, rope and stripe weave cord cloth in light tan or blue. The Convertible Coupe is smartly finished

in combination leather and whipcord or soft top-grain leather throughout in a choice of five colors: tan, red, blue, green and black.

Custom Interiors—For those who desire individuality, Lincoln offers a choice of Custom Interiors at a price that is surprisingly low for such luxury. Four beautiful interior color schemes are available in fabrics and tailoring of superb quality. You have your choice of Custom Maroon, Custom Blue, Custom Green and Custom Tan with side wall and headlining materials in harmonizing shades. All Custom materials have shadow-stripe pattern that enhances their rich appearance. Rear center arm rest is included.

Equipment—Translucent plastic steering wheel and medallion with full horn ring, automatic cigar lighter in front and rear compartments, two ash trays, electric clock, glove compartment with lock, dual windshield wipers, two adjustable sun visors, front and rear side arm rests, hassocks in rear compartments, rear view mirror, dual synchronized horns, bumpers with two bumper guards, rear wheel shields, twin tail-lamps, turn signals, Sealed-Beam headlamps, safety glass in windshield and side windows, direction signals front and rear, tempered glass in curved rear window, hydraulic window lifts, Hydraulic Lift-Top on Convertible Coupe.

Choice of Interiors—In the Continental Coupe, you have a wide choice of interior color schemes and materials from which to choose. Luxurious Custom Cloth with shadow-stripe pattern is available in four rich colors: maroon, blue,

green and tan. Or, if you prefer, Continental Coupe interiors are available in smart combinations of leather and whipcord in a choice of five colors: tan, red, blue, green or black. The Continental Cabriolet is upholstered in soft top-grain leather throughout or in combinations of leather and whipcord in the same choice of the five colors listed above.

Ultra-Modern Instrument Panel—Functionally designed and distinctive in appearance, the Continental instrument panel is distinguished by its softly gleaming chrome decorations and rich blue dials set on a background of deep lustrous blue. Spacious Luggage Compartment—There's oceans of room for

luggage, sports equipment and packages under the sleek Continental rear deck. With its 18.25 cubic feet of space, this compartment is among the largest in the fine-car field. Deck lid fits snugly to provide complete protection from dust and water.

Cabriolet Frame Design—The Continental Cabriolet frame incorporates bridge-floor construction with double box-section side rails for utmost rigidity and high torsional strength.

Continental Equipment—Translucent plastic steering wheel with maroon-silver medallion and full horn ring, automatic

cigar lighter in front and rear compartments, two ash trays, electric clock, glove compartment with lock, dual windshield wipers, two adjustable sun visors, front and rear side arm rests, rear center arm rest in Coupe, hassocks in rear compartments, rear view mirror, two synchronized horns, bumpers with two bumper guards, rear wheel shields, twin taillamps, stop lamp, direction signals front and rear, rear wheel shields, Sealed-Beam headlamps, metal tire cover to match car finish, safety glass in windshield and side windows—tempered glass in curved rear window, automatic hydraulic window lifts, Hydraulic Lift-Top on Cabriolet.
